On April 13, 2018, The Center for Disease Control and Prevention issued a broad scale public health notice indicating that chopped romaine lettuce from the Yuma, AZ growing region could be contaminated with E. coli O157:H7. The CDC and public health and regulatory officials in several states are investigating outbreaks in 11 states.

There is no indication that any Taylor Farms products were a source, regardless of growing region. To date, Taylor Farms has not been contacted by any federal agencies regarding this matter. No specific product recalls have been initiated.
